



# St Francis College NEW YORK

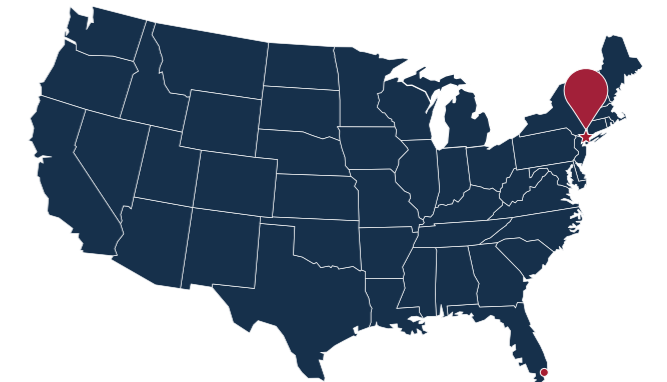
